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# **Toilet Policy**

All participants and coaches must go to the toilet before class starts.

Coaches can use the toilet in between classes, but not during.

## What toilet do the participants use?

Participants use the disabled toilet (not the male's or female's), in the same corridor, just a few doors down from our gymnasium. This is so we can make sure they are not accompanied by anyone else.

### Can the coach take a participant to the toilet and help them?

No, Gymnastics coaches are not allowed to help or take a child of any age to the toilet. They remain inside the gymnasium but may briefly leave to show the participant where the toilet is and how to lock/unlock the door. This disabled toilet door can be unlocked with a tool from the outside if in case of an emergency.

#### Can participants use the toilet bare foot?

No, for hygiene purposes, slip on sliders must be worn when going to the toilet. We have a selection of sizes in the hallway for everyone to use.

#### How do you know if the participants washed their hands or not?

Coaches cannot know for sure if the participant washed their hands after using the toilet, so hand sanitiser is given when returning to the gymnasium.

Pre-School Classes (3-4yrs): Parents/Guardians must stay local to the gymnasium in case their child needs to go to the toilet and they can assist.

Parents/guardians must make sure the club has their current mobile number.

General Gymnastics Classes (4yrs+): When a participant goes to the disabled toilet, the gymnasium door remains open so the coach can supervise the toilet/hallway until the child returns. If a child cannot use the toilet alone in these classes, their parent/guardian must stay local so that coaches can phone to assist. Parents/guardians must make sure the club has their current mobile number.
